

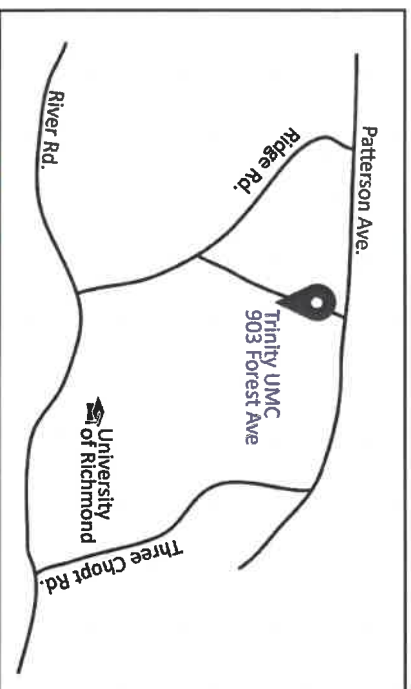
The Dillard Forum is a ministry of Trinity United Methodist Church designed to examine how faith communities speak to the 21st century. An annual event featuring a theologian or biblical scholar, the Forum was established in 2003 to honor F. Douglas Dillard, Jr. who, with his wife Marion, served Trinity for eight years (1981-1989) as senior minister and later three and a half years as minister of congregational care. An eloquent teacher and scholar, Dr. Dillard died in 2005.

With a Special Session of the General Conference taking place in February 2019, the United Methodist Church, like other mainline Protestant denominations before it, is at a crossroads over issues of inclusion of LGBTQ persons. A speaker and author, his latest books include *Defying Gravity: Break Free From the Culture of More and Restored: Finding Redemption in our Mess*. Tom serves as the Chair of the Board of Governors for Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington, D.C., the clergy leader of the Virginia Annual Conference delegation to the 2016 and 2019 General Conferences and was a member of the Commission on a Way Forward.
