Opening Family Prayer

Holy God,

You hear our words and you know our hearts.

Thank you for loving us and holding us close to you. Amen.

Holy Week

Each day read these scripture passages together as a family. Take your time, read in small sections. If possible, one reading each day, set up with suggested Prop/Images.

- 1.) April 5: The Last Supper Matthew 26:26-29, Props Loaf of Bread and Cup of juice
- 2.) April 6: A Place to Pray Matthew 26:36-46, Props go outdoors or use potted plants
- 3.) April 7: An Arrest Matthew 26:47-64, Props toy swords
- 4.) April 8: A Betrayal Matthew 26:69-75, Props your fire pit or sticks and red tissue paper
- 5.) April 9 Holy Thursday: A Trial <u>Matthew 27:11-26</u>, Props make a throne out of a large chair and cover it with red or purple cloth
- 6.) April 10 Good Friday: A Death Matthew 27:32-53, Props a small decorative cross
- 7.) April 11: A Burial Matthew 27:55-61, Props length of white fabric or a sheet

Family Discussion

- How would you feel on Palm Sunday, when you saw Jesus riding into Jerusalem on a donkey and people were shouting, "Hosanna, Hosanna in the highest! Blessed is he, who comes in the name of the Lord!" Would you be joyful?
- As the week progresses and you read the additional scriptures, is there one of the sections or stories of Holy week that stands out to you, if so which one and why?

Create a Prayer

There are many emotions in the selections of scripture for Holy week: joy and excitement on Palm Sunday and then fear, sadness, anger, betrayal, violence, exhaustion, and desperation. Have you experienced any of these emotions, if so, when? Can you think of folks who may have experienced any of these feelings? Who are they and can you pray for them? Ask God to enter into their sadness and to take their sadness and to give them hope in their heart. Create a prayer and write it down so that you can add to it next week and perhaps watch your prayers being answered!
