Glorious Gifts is an alternative way of shopping for Christmas gifts while supporting the outreach ministries of Reveille United Methodist Church.

Each of our outreach ministries has created a shopping list of needed items that you can “buy.” Instead of receiving the item, you will receive one card (if that option is selected) for each item, listing the item purchased, and explaining the ministry. You may give the card to a friend or family member as a gift. You also may make a general donation without specifying an item. All money donated through Glorious Gifts will be used to fund the specific ministry to which it was donated.

If you do not need cards, please check the box on the printed or online order form. For orders placed online or by mail, printed cards will be available for pick up in the church office (8:30 am-4:30 pm, Monday-Friday) three to five days after receiving the order. You will be notified by email when your cards are ready for pick up.

Shop in person in the welcome center December 7 and 14, 9:00-11:15 am (credit cards, checks, and cash accepted), shop and pay online at www.reveilleumc.org/glorious-gifts, or drop off or mail your order to the church office. Make checks payable to Reveille UMC.

Place your order by December 22 to receive printed cards by Christmas Eve. If you do not need cards, the deadline to place your order is December 31.

Outreach Ministries and Shopping Lists

Food Insecurity Initiatives in Richmond

Food insecurity has become an increasingly urgent problem. In 2026, Reveille intends to expand our outreach ministries to partner with organizations that seek to address food insecurity by providing increased financial and volunteer support.

Richmond Friends of the Homeless is devoted to making a difference in the lives of the less advantaged in Richmond. Reveille volunteers provide meals and prayerful support for up to 200 people twice each month, with fourth Monday bagged lunches and fourth Thursday hot meals.

Koinonia Community Church Food Pantry is supported by our partner church in the Swansboro area and by donations from Reveille food drives.

Belmont Food Pantry is the largest food pantry in the Richmond area, providing food recently for nearly 1,000 families each week. The pantry is open every Friday, supported by volunteers from area churches and the community.

Fonticello Food Forest is a community resource within Carter-Jones/Fonticello Park in the Swansboro area. Food is distributed every Wednesday. Reveille volunteers, including Kids Camp, help at Fonticello. Donations support distributions from FeedMore.

Shalom Farms works to grow and distribute fresh produce in Richmond areas where access to healthy food is limited.
